But did you know he went through MANY moments of utter disappointment?

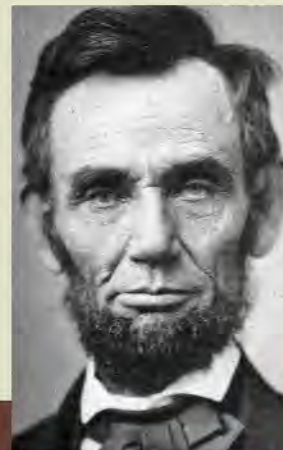

| 1834 | -Age 25, Elected to legislature | 1859 | -Age 50 hesitantly agreed to run for the presidency |
| 1835 | -Sweetheart (Ann Rutledge) died | 1860 | -Elected as President of the USA |
| 1836 | -Had nervous breakdown; was re-elected to lead a delegation; received license to practice law in Illinois | | |
| 1838 | -Age 29 nominated as Speaker, but Defeated | | |
| 1839 | -Age 30, chosen as presidential elector; also admitted to practice law in U.S. Circuit Court. | | |
| 1840 | -At age 31, was re-elected to Illinois State Legislature. | | |
| 1843 | -Age 34, Defeated for nomination for Congress | | |
| 1846 | -At age 37, Elected to Congress | | |
| 1848 | -At age 39, Lost the renomination for Congress | | |
| 1849 | -Age 40, Rejected for Land Officer | | |

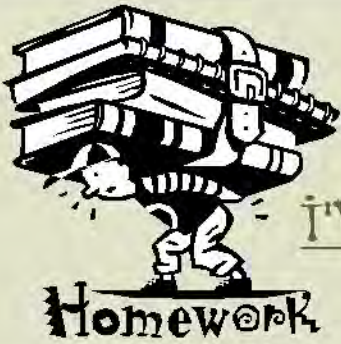
Lincoln went on to be one the greatest examples of truth, righteousness, prayer & commitment.
